

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF KINGSLEY, IOWA

April 15, 2024 7:00 P.M. Meeting Minutes

A. CALL TO ORDER

The Kingsley City Council met in regular session on April 15, 2024. Those present were Councilmen Rolling, Baker, Beelner, Bohle and Jasperson. Mayor Bohle presided over the meeting.

The agenda was approved on motion by Baker, seconded by Beelner, all voted aye, motion carried.

Old Business:

- a. Public hearing on the matter of proposed budget for fiscal year 2024-2025. The city tax rate will be 13.24419 per \$1000 property valuation. The hearing was opened at 7:15 p.m. on motion by Bohle, seconded by Jasperson, all voted aye, motion carried. Hearing was closed at 7:19 p.m. on motion by Bohle, seconded by Jasperson, all voted aye, motion carried. Budget was approved (Resolution 2024-8) on motion by Bohle, seconded by Jasperson, all voted aye, motion carried.
- b. K-P Little League (fields and grants) was tabled.

New Business:

- a. Ash borer treatment was discussed. City can't sell the liquid treatment to residents but the city can treat them. Price for treatment to be determined.
- b. Tourism grants were discussed.
- c. Cemetery burials: City Council was asked to set a standard for the size of excavation for a cremation burial. Standard size will be 18" x 18" by 24". A gas-powered auger and larger wagon will be purchased for this purpose on motion by Bohle, seconded by Baker, all voted aye, motion carried.
- d. Council discussed a proposed land purchase. There are 13.45 acres available in the northwest section of the city. The Council will contact the sellers.
- e. Adjournment on motion by Jasperson, seconded by Baker, all voted aye, motion carried.
